

## HOKAMI, RADIONICS, HOMEOPATHY

1. Acts 19:19—Ephesians burned books of magic
2. Messages to Young People, p. 275—Books were instructions in the worship of Satan and directions in divination.
3. Mind/Body Science—Somatic Therapies
4. Hakomi—body centered psychotherapy. Blending Western psychology with Eastern mysticism as a therapeutic modality. Ron Kurtz, originator, is a Buddhist Psychologist.
5. Principles of his premise:
  1. All is one: one is all
  2. Create awareness
  3. To have compassion
  4. Trust wisdom from within
  5. Body/mind relationship
6. The goal is to achieve unity—all in one and on in all, freedom from suffering.
7. It uses tools of “mind changing power” such as passivity, visualization, relaxation, and rhythmic breathing.
8. You must organize and change beliefs to accept Eastern mysticism and the **divine** within.
9. Lightbody consciousness in Hakomi is to blend our energy (aura) with some object of nature (aura).
10. This is achieved by the use of visualization of a golden light to create a body filled with this light and a light cocoon around the body of six inches beyond. Deep rhythmic breathing through the nose is essential to reach the desired state. One must understand that the lightbody blends with the physical body. **“Taking the awareness outside of the body and light cocoon, and looking down on the body lying below, deepens the process, particularly enabling detached and neutral observation.”** [Lightbody Consciousness in Hakomi by Wolfgang Ronnefeldt, MA]

## DIVINATION AND RADIONICS

11. Deut. 18:9-14 tells us not to use divination.
12. Several common healing disciplines claim in their literature that they use the pendulum in their methods.
13. Iridology was made popular by the late Bernard Benson D.C. and is used around the world. Of ancient origin, it is a form of divination. It is not shown to be in agreement with science of ophthalmology or optometry and has not stood up to critical testing.
14. Psychometry is divination by psychic or clairvoyant means. Radionics is the same but aided by adding a machine. A machine is not really necessary.
15. Results depend on the operator’s psycho-spiritual development.
16. Radionics is based on the premise that all matter has vibrations of electromagnetic energy that the machine can detect and identify. Use of these methods is possible over vast distances. Machines are supposed to send corrective frequencies back into the person receiving treatment. This is not supported by science.

## HOMEOPATHY

17. Originator: Christian Hahnemann M.D., a German physician in 1790's in Germany.
18. He was a spiritist and follower of Emmanuel Swedenborg a renowned spiritualist.
19. He was a believer in the theory of vitalism (universal energy).
20. He developed a system of giving medicinal therapy by the use of extremely diluted doses.
21. Dilutions can go as far as removing all known molecules of the original substance and the more diluted the more powerful the remedy.
22. An "essence" was said to have been passed by the original substance to the water diluents and in turn to the patient. The essence is considered subtle energy.
23. This system had wide spread use for two hundred years and is still widely used in Western and Eastern Europe. Interest in and use of it is returning in America. The system has not stood up to quality science testing.
24. **Dr. Green states the following: "Why did biofeedback prove helpful in the treatment of so many and varied disorders? Suddenly I realized that it isn't biofeedback that is the 'panacea'—it is the power within the human being to self-regulate, self-heal, re-balance. Biofeedback does nothing to the person; it is a tool for releasing that potential."**
